Amberg Corp. is pursuing its ISO 14065 accreditation.

Amberg has long been a leader in the quantification and verification of industrial greenhouse gas emissions. Staff members are trained and certified under ISO 14064(3) "*Specification with guidance for the validation and verification of greenhouse gas assertions*" and have contributed to approximately 70 greenhouse gas inventories or verification reports over the past five years. As a progression of mastery in this field, Amberg Corp. is pursuing company accreditation under ISO 14065 "*Requirements for greenhouse gas validation and verification bodies for use in accreditation or other forms of recognition*" through the Standards Council of Canada. The aim of this accreditation is to give confidence to parties which rely on greenhouse gas assertions. The party making the assertion is responsible for conformity with program requirements (such as regulations) and the verification body is responsible for completing an objective assessment and providing an evidence based verification statement. The principles of the ISO 14065 accreditation demonstrate that the company has met the standard's requirements for performing competent and consistent greenhouse gas assessments.
